

Timely Filing of a Review Petition for Workers' Comp Case

In the case of *Pizza Hut, Inc. v. Workers' Compensation Appeal Board (Mahalick)*, on appeal, the employer argued that the claimant's review petition was time-barred, because it was not filed within three years of the last payment of compensation. The Court did not accept the employer's argument and affirmed the grant of a review petition to expand the work injury and the denial of a [timely filed termination petition](#). It reasoned that under *Cinram* the judge would have been empowered to correctively amend the NCP and that, thus, the statute of limitation does not apply.
