## 6/18/15 – Matt Wilson Becomes Seventh "Certified Specialist" at Martin

For a dozen years, he has served as a contributing author of the "bible" of the practice, "Workers' Compensation Practice & Procedure," a 900 page textbook distributed at the biannual Pennsylvania Bar Institute conference of the same name.
